

## **Why Have A Privacy Policy?**

This page will describe management of our web site as regards processing the personal data of users who visit us.

The information provided only applies to our web site and does not concern any web sites that may be visited by users via external links.

The information provided is also based on the guidelines contained in Recommendation no. 2/2001, which was adopted on 17 May 2001 by the European data protection authorities within the Working Party set up under Article 29 of European Directive 95/46/EC in order to lay down minimum requirements for the collection of personal data online - especially with regard to arrangements, timing and contents of the information to be provided by data controllers to users visiting web pages for whatever purpose.

### Cookie policy

Fulfilling the obligations under Art. 10 of the Directive n. 95/46 / EC, Directive 2002/58 / EC, as updated by Directive 2009/136 / EC, Article 13 of Legislative Decree June 30, 2003, number 196, and the general measure (Doc. Web no. 3118884 ) of the Authority for the Protection of Personal Data, published in the Official Gazette no. 126 of June 3, 2014, record of the action no. 229 of 8 May 2014 regarding Cookies, we proceed with providing information on the related issues.

## **Categories of Processed Data**

### *Navigation Data*

The information systems and software procedures relied upon to operate this web site acquire personal data as part of their standard functioning; the transmission of such data is an inherent feature of Internet communication protocols.

Such information is not collected in order to relate it to identified data subjects, however it might allow user identification per se after being processed and matched with data held by third parties.

This data category includes IP addresses and/or the domain names of the computers used by any user connecting with this web site, the URI (Uniform Resource Identifier) addresses of the requested resources, the time of such requests, the method used for submitting a given request to the server, returned file size, a numerical code relating to server response status (successfully performed, error, etc.), and other parameters related to the user's operating system and computer environment.

These data are only used to extract anonymous statistical information on website use as well as to check its functioning; they are erased immediately after being processed. The data might be used to establish liability if

computer crimes are committed against the website; except for this circumstance, any data on web contacts is currently retained for no longer than seven days.

### ***Data Provided Voluntarily by Users***

Sending e-mail messages to the addresses mentioned on this website, which is done on the basis of a freely chosen, explicit, and voluntary option, entails acquisition of the sender's address, which is necessary in order to reply to any request, as well as of such additional personal data as is contained in the message(s).

Specific summary information notices will be shown and/or displayed on the pages that are used for providing services on demand.

### *Cookies*

#### **What are cookies?**

Cookies are small texts that are installed on your computer or smartphone and tablet when you surf the web. When you visit the web, each page sends cookies to the browser (eg Internet Explorer, Mozilla Firefox, Google Chrome, Safari, Opera), it stores them and make them come out everytime you visit the same page. Cookies may also be sent to your browser from web sites or from different servers by third parties. This means that whilst browsing a specific website elements from other sites that have these cookies, such as images, sounds, maps, links to other pages may appear.

Depending on the type of cookies and on their purpose, data from the user can be stored and saved, for example, in order to make use of a site more effective, to enable a specific functionality, to monitor visit sessions.

In particular, cookies allow you to store your search preferences, to avoid having to repeatedly enter the same information during navigation (such as your username and password), to analyze the use and content of the services provided by a website, and to optimize the browsing experience and services.

<http://www.sintechology.com/> uses a technical cookie which is intended to seek consent from the user for the sole purpose of ensuring the normal navigation and use of the website, to collect information on the site and to get a statistical analysis of pages viewed by users

No personal data of users is collected by the site.

We do not use cookies to transmit information of a personal nature, nor do we use cd cookies of any kind, or systems for tracking users.

The use of session cookies (which are not stored permanently on the user's computer and disappear when the browser is closed) is strictly limited to transmitting session identifiers (consisting of random numbers generated by the server) necessary to enable the 'safe and efficient' website.

Session cookies used on this site avoid the use of other technologies that could compromise the privacy of the users and do not allow the acquisition of personal identification data.

Analytics Cookies can be sent both from our website, and from third-party domains and do not in any way allow the acquisition of personal identification data. Analytics Cookies, if installed by third parties (eg. Google Analytics), and in spite of collecting data anonymously, shall be treated as cookie profiling, as indicated by the Authority for the Protection of Personal Data.

#### **How to disable our cookies**

You can, at any time, turn off the cookies used by our website independently. Generally, it depends on the disabling browser you use.

### **Optional Data Provision**

For the sake of completeness, it should be pointed out that in some cases – which are not the subject of the standard management of this website – our Authority may request information pursuant to **Section 157(1) of Legislative Decree no. 196/2003** with a view to supervising the processing of personal data. In these cases,, it is mandatory to comply under penalty of administrative penalties.

### **Processing Arrangements**

Personal data is processed with automated means for no longer than is necessary to achieve the purposes for which it has been collected.

Specific security measures are implemented to prevent the data from being lost, used unlawfully and/or inappropriately, and accessed without authorisation.

### **Data Subjects' Rights**

Data subjects are entitled at any time to obtain confirmation of the existence of personal data concerning them and be informed of their contents and origin, verify their accuracy, or else request that such data be supplemented, updated or rectified (**Section 7 of Legislative Decree no. 196/2003**).

The above Section also provides for the right to request erasure, anonymisation or blocking of any data that is processed in breach of the law as well as to object in all cases, on legitimate grounds, to processing of the data.
